

Spelling Words for Year 2

These 61 words are those that all children should be able to read and spell accurately by the end of Year 2. They are often called 'high frequency' or 'common exception' words as we use them all the time and yet they often don't follow conventional spelling patterns.

Every week, your child is sent home with a set of words from this list and we would be grateful if you could help them with the learning of these. Your child will be tested at the end of each half term on all the words that they have been practising over the previous weeks. Results of these tests will be sent home for parents.
